POBLE ESPANYOL: The Poble Espanvol is an architectural open air museum in Montjuïc in Barcelona, just a few meters from the Magic Fountain. It was built for the 1929 Barcelona International Exhibition as the pavilion dedicated to art, and right from the start, it was conceived as a real 'village' in the heart of a city. This is why 117 buildings, streets and squares from different

architectural styles from all around Spain were reproduced to scale. It is one of the biggest attractions of the city because of a single set featuring about contemporary art, architecture, crafts and gastronomy in a peaceful environment.

The houses were low-rise and small in scale so as not to obstruct views of the city.
